



## PFFUI Affiliate Leader Scholarship Program

The PFFUI offers scholarships to enable two individuals, from separate Locals with 99 or fewer active members, the ability to attend an IAFF function each year.

The scholarships will assist representatives to attend the IAFF Convention in even numbered years and in odd numbered years, the scholarship will be to attend an IAFF conference determined by the President of the PFFUI. The scholarship will include registration fees, transportation, lodging, and other reasonable and necessary business related expenses approved by the PFFUI President.

- Applications must be from members of a Local's Executive Board.
- Applications must include:
  - Letter of recommendation from the Local President (if the applicant is not the President).
  - Letter of interest from the applicant.
  - A statement of commitment from the Local or the individual to provide for time off-duty, at their expense, as necessary for travel and attendance at the function.
- Letters of application shall be emailed to the President of the PFFUI for consideration.
- Criteria considered will include, but not be limited to:
  - Participation and attendance in PFFUI activities and events.
  - Participation in the Indiana Firefighters PAC.
  - The Local's per capita payments must be current with both the PFFUI and the IAFF.
- The President shall award the scholarships, with the concurrence of the PFFUI Executive Board, and notify the individuals selected.
- The PFFUI will approve and coordinate travel arrangements and expense reimbursements or allotments with the individuals selected.
- The individual will be expected to submit a brief report or article for possible publication in the PFFUI Newsletter detailing their experience.
